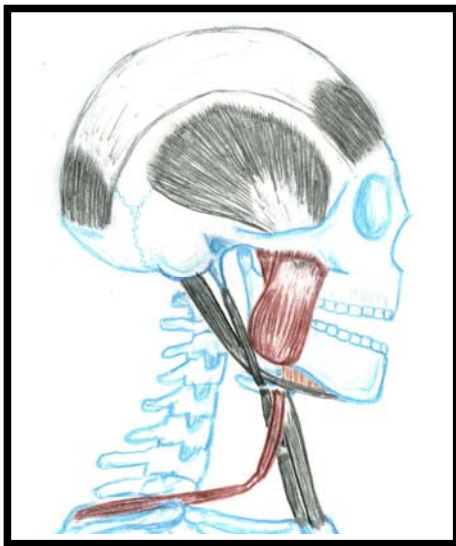

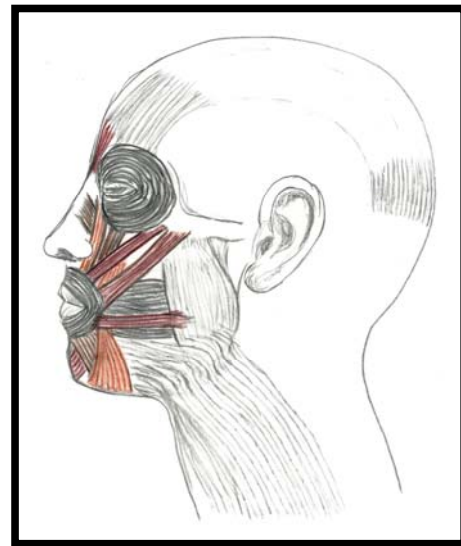

Intraoral work is now legal in Washington State for LMPs who obtain an Intraoral Endorsement on their massage license. Manual therapy techniques inside the oral cavity are extremely valuable when working with clients with temporomandibular joint (TMJ) dysfunction, headaches, whiplash, and a host of other issues. Working inside the mouth requires specific knowledge and skills, so a special 16-hour intraoral education requirement must be met by LMPs in order to apply to the WA Health Department and Massage Board for their endorsement.

This workshop presents an in-depth look at the neck, jaw, cranium and oral cavity, including plenty of hands-on techniques. Hands-on work will be integrated with clear anatomy and palpation skills, so that you can effectively and confidently work with clients in your day-to-day practice. Our focus will be to provide a clear and confident basis for performing intraoral manual therapy with your clients.

In this class we will:

- Delve into this fascinating area of the body, drawing on the experience of the instructor and incorporating the collective insights of the class participants.
- Review anatomy, physiology and kinesiology of the oral cavity, TMJ, cranium, neck, and many related structures.
- Explore a variety of hands-on bodywork techniques for working inside the oral cavity, as well as balancing related structures outside the oral cavity. Techniques will be drawn from craniosacral therapy, neuromuscular therapy, positional release, and more, and will be tailored to the needs and experience of the class participants.
- Learn intraoral hygienic practices, safety and sanitation, pathology and contraindications.

DAVE CAMPBELL, LMP, is a licensed massage practitioner and instructor of Kinesiology and Cadaver Anatomy at the Spectrum Center School of Massage in Lake Stevens, WA since 2001. He has been in practice for over 20 years and has an enduring fascination with the intricacies of the human body, mind, and spirit. He maintains a full-time practice in Bellingham, WA.

Dave is the author and illustrator of the book *Mastering Muscles & Movement: A Brain-Friendly System for Learning Musculoskeletal Anatomy and Kinesiology* (for more information, visit www.bodylightbooks.com) He holds a B.A. in Mathematics from the University of California and is a CranioSacral Therapist and a Trager[®] Practitioner. Campbell, a former key engineer at the Fairchild Research Labs in Palo Alto, CA, developed his brain-friendly approach to teaching anatomy and technique based on years of experience in the study of human perception, artificial intelligence, and graphic representation of scientific information.
